## STATUTES FOR COUNTRY ASSOCIATIONS, February 2007

### 1. Name and legal status

The IAAP is the governing body (within the Medical Section of the School of Spiritual Science) for national Anthroposophic Pharmacists Associations and is constituted according to Swiss Law article 60 S.1.ZGB.

### 2. Aims and objectives of the IAAP

- To set standards for National Associations who wish to be recognised as members of the IAAP within the Medical Section of the School of Spiritual Science.
- To represent, at International level, Anthroposophic Medicine including regulatory and legal affairs from the professional pharmacists perspective: Anthroposophic pharmacy being seen as an "extension" of conventional pharmacy.
- To award international accreditation of Anthroposophic Pharmacists training materials and publications.
- To facilitate collegueship between Anthroposophic Pharmacists world-wide by the active building of community between Anthroposophic Pharmacists
- To liase with:
  - Other disciplines in the Medical Section, in the School of Spiritual Science
  - Other sections in the School of Spiritual Science
  - Recognised National Anthroposophic Pharmacists Associations
  - National Pharmacists Associations seeking recognition by IAAP
  - Other interest groups related to anthroposophic pharmacy.

For the purpose of:

organising workshops/conferences

widening Anthroposophic Pharmacy awareness, especially in retail pharmacists

research into Anthroposophic Pharmaceutical matters

- To act as a centre of information for individual Anthroposophic Pharmacists and Pharmacists Associations to share best practice world-wide.
- To act as an initiator/co-ordinator for activities which require international action.
- To facilitate individual membership (see Statutes for country associations addendum for individual members).

### 3. Membership

The IAAP is the umbrella organisation for the several national Associations of Anthroposophic Pharmacists and individual members.

Criteria that a National Anthroposophic Pharmacists Association has to achieve to be recognised and approved by IAAP.

A National Association should strive to be a legally constituted association in its own country

## 3.2 Membership Criteria

There are essentially 3 types of member in any recognised National Association

- Members with voting rights at the Annual General Meeting (Members and Honorary Members)
- Members without voting rights (Associates)
- Honorary Members – are at the discretion of the country board – they must be elected by a unanimous board decision and they should be few in number.

For a National Association to be recognised and approved by the IAAP people identified as Members of the National Association must be:

- (a) A Pharmacist who has passed all examinations to be recognised as a fully responsible, professional pharmacist. In addition he/she should be registered with a nationally recognised professional pharmacists association.
- (b) A Member of the Anthroposophic Society or supporter of a set of Anthroposophic guiding principles appropriate to the profession of pharmacist. (see IAAP Guiding Principles for an Anthroposophic Pharmacist).

In addition there must be clearly defined criteria specifying Anthroposophic Pharmaceutical experience and Anthroposophic knowledge/study.

## 3.3 The Association must have in place:

- a maintained register of individual members of the association
- a complaint mechanism for members of the public
- a disciplinary procedure that is accessible to the public

## 4. Exclusion of an IAAP representative

4.1 Any Member may be excluded from the IAAP by a written paper given to the Board of Management.

4.2 By decision of the Board of Management - any Member can be excluded on the grounds of severe interference with the objectives or the work of the IAAP on the basis of gross infraction of his/her duties.

## 5. Annual assembly

There will be an opportunity annually, which coincides with The Medical Section Conference in Dornach, for all participating Anthroposophic to meet and share issues and directions of the IAAP.

## 6. Composition of the board of management

## Board Members

One representative from each recognised and approved National Association

Individual Pharmacists Representatives (see addendum I)

## Invited Member

The Leader of the Medical Section, School of Spiritual Science (or a Nominee, acceptable to the Members of the Board).

## Co-opted Members

The Board may invite individuals/organisations to participate as co-opted members to help in the achievement of the aims and objectives of the IAAP.

## 7. Auditors

The IAAP secretary is responsible for the auditors.

## 8. Contributions and liability of IAAP and its members

8.1 The IAAP is founded without starting capital. The financial budget of the IAAP will be effected by annual membership contributions and other contributions. The annual membership contribution will be voted by the Board.

8.2 There is no personal liability of the members of the IAAP. For liabilities of the association only the property of the association can be taken.

## 9. Dissolution and liquidation

9.1 The Board may decide on the dissolution of the IAAP with an affirmative of not less than two-thirds of the votes cast.

9.2 If the Board has decided on the dissolution of the IAAP, the IAAP shall be liquidated by the Board of Management or one or more liquidators appointed by the Board.

## 10. Language

These guidelines for the IAAP are presented in the German and English language.
